



Passing on the Gift of Jesus

The reason why we can celebrate Christmas, and more specifically the birth of Jesus, is that Mary cooperated with God's invitation to be the mother of God. In a sense, Mary has given us the gift of Jesus. During this Christmas season, it is good to consider how we can do the same for others. We do not have to start in a different country or preaching to the Churchless of Australia but rather with our own families and the people with whom we live. If we can show charity to those who are closest to us then we can show it to almost anyone. The best thing is that we get so many opportunities to grow within our own families that we could easily become saints in a short period of time.

Once we have begun passing on Jesus within own families then we are in a far better position to reach out to others. Part of the reasoning behind this is that if we have our own house in order, then we are in a better position to try help clean up other people's houses. Of course, in this discussion, we need to remember that it is Jesus who does the real work, we simply open the gate. 1. Mother of Our Creator Curia Normanhurst

Door to door visitation, Distribution of Miraculous Medals, Holy card, rosary beads and leaflets, provide car transport for elderly and those who had difficulties in obtaining transports. Helping out in the parish. Teaching catechism were 14 children were baptised 23 children had their first Holy Communion and 24 children received the sacrament of Confirmation. Introduced the faith to 71 people and 48 were successful. Searched out for new parishioners

2. Spouse of the Holy Spirit Praesidium North Ryde

Work Done; Visitation to hospital, nursing home and Auxiliary members.

Rosary statues circulation. Catechism classes, assist Father with the monthly Mass, and the CIC shop until the closure of the shop, rosary prayed at requiem mass

3. Our Lady of Perpetual Help Praesidium Kensington

Work Done: : Visitation to home, nursing home, hospitals and auxiliary member. Assisting CIC Shop. Rosary prayer at home and lead rosary before mass also conducted as the Church Ministry and wardens Rosary statues circulation. Bring people to learn catholic church and become new Catechumen. Open new legion after recruitment in CIC Campbelltown.

4. Mother of Our Saviour Praesidium -Camperdown

Work Done: Visit the sick when requested by the priest, helping arrange flowers in church ,statue circulation and one member assists with Senatus office duty and , assisting CIC shop.

5. Immaculate Heart of Mary, Wollongong

Work Done: Catechism classes in public schools, visitation to homes, nursing homes, hospitals. Distribution of miraculous Medal, rosary prayer at home, before funeral and in church before mass. Altar linen and flower ministry; extraordinary minister of Holy Communion.
